Calizona Appaloosa Horse Club along with Lazy Faire Ranch in West Cajon Valley, California is co-sponsoring the 6<sup>th</sup> annual benefit trail ride for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital on May 3, 2008. Riders of all ages and their horses or mules are invited to "Saddle Up" & participate. The cost/donation is \$30.00 per rider if registered by April 26, or \$40.00 at the door. An approximate three-hour ride will depart from the Lazy Faire Ranch to the historic Mormon Rocks and return. Two paths will be available, one easy meandering path or one to challenge more experienced riders. A silent auction/raffle will be held also of various items - many equestrian related.

Cancer is the leading disease killer of American children and St. Jude is the leading center for the study of these diseases. Approximately 4,000 children are currently being seen at St. Jude. St. Jude covers all costs not covered by insurance. Families without insurance are never asked to pay. St. Jude is supported by public contributions. Monies raised from this event will build an endowment fund to ensure St. Jude's continued efforts. Prior years' events have risen over \$2,000. *Have fun – Help save lives and Saddle Up for St. Jude!*

Please pack out all litter

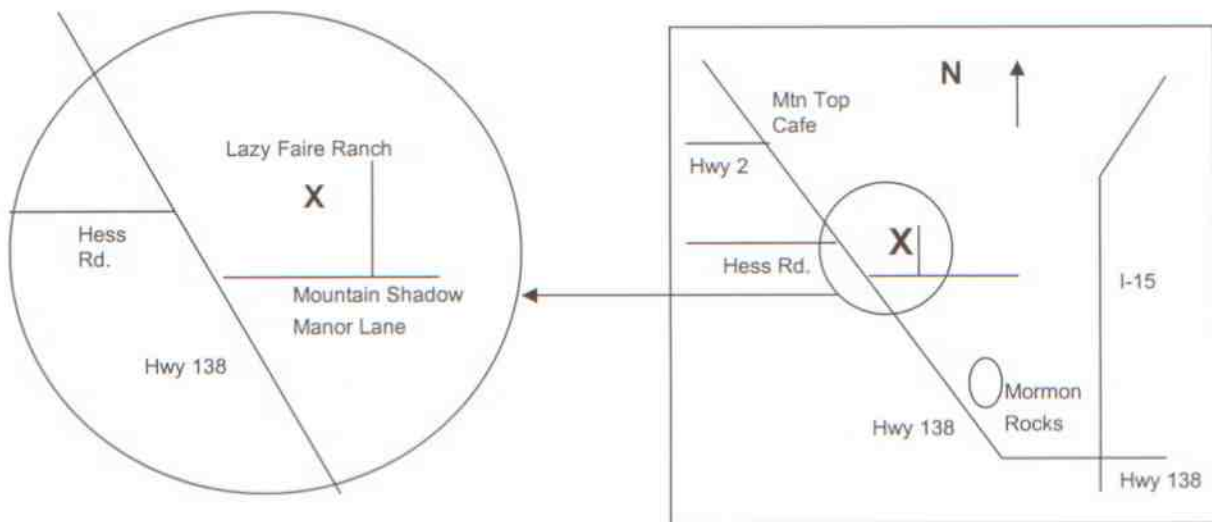
## DIRECTIONS TO LAZY FAIRE RANCH:

### Traveling South-East on Highway 138

From the junction of Hwy 2 and Hwy 138, proceed southeast on Hwy 138 approximately 5 miles to the junction of Mountain Manor Rd. This is ¼ mile past Hess Road (beginning of 2 lanes southbound). Look for the Lazy Faire Ranch sign on the left side of road. Turn left onto the dirt road and continue east ¼ mile until you cross a small wash. Look for the Lazy Faire Ranch sign. Turn left for parking.

### Traveling North on I-15 or I-215

From the I-215, merge with the I-15 and continue heading north to Victorville. From the I-15, continue northbound and exit to Hwy 138 (just past the truck scales). Turn left at the stop sign, westbound over the freeway. Continue northwest on Hwy 138 approximately 6 miles to Mountain Shadow Manor Road. Look for the Lazy Faire Ranch sign on the right and make a right turn onto the dirt road. If you pass Hess Rd, you have gone too far.



## Waiver, Release and Indemnity Agreement

The undersigned individual for himself or herself, his or her spouse and/or his or her children (hereinafter collectively and individually referred to as the "undersigned", for and in consideration of allowing the Undersigned to participate in the "Benefit Trail Ride" (hereinafter referred to as the "Event") and /or in consideration of the opportunity to participate in the purpose, objectives, and work of St. Jude Children's Research Hospital Inc., American Lebanese Syrian Associated Charities, Inc., the Municipalities, Counties, or other local governments in or through which the "Event" takes place or is conducted, and any other person, entity or sponsor connected with the Event and their respective officers, directors, agents and employees and their heirs, executors, representatives, administrators, successors, and assigns (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Released Parties"), the Undersigned does hereby voluntarily and forever release and discharges the Released Parties and their respective officers, directors, agents and employees from any and all claims, actions, and/or liability of any type or kind (including but not limited to; damages for personal injury) that the Undersigned at any time may have or sustain as a result of participating in the Event and/or in any way receiving goods, services instruction in any way of anything else connected with the Event, by or a result of any action or inaction of the Released Parties and/or their respective officers, directors, agents and employees or other acts or omissions of any type or kind relating to the Event, regardless of wherever the event is held. The Undersigned fully understands, acknowledges and agrees that by participating in the Event there is the possibility of accidental or other physical injury. Nonetheless, the Undersigned further agrees to assume the risk of personal injury, and any and all other risk or any loss or injury of any type or kind whatsoever, including loss of uses and any other indirect or consequential damages which the undersigned may suffer, resulting directly or indirectly, wholly or in part, from the Event, and further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Released parties, the respective officers, directors, agents and employees from any and all loss, cost or expense suffered, and claims, demands, actions damages and judgments of any nature asserted against the Released Parties as a result of the Undersigned's participation in the Event. In the event any provision of this Waiver, Release and Indemnity Agreement is found invalid or enforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall not be affected thereby and shall be enforced to the extent permitted by law.
